Legislative Report, July 2023

The National Center for Youth Law calls on U.N. Forum to address anti-Black racism in schools

Every child deserves to freely learn, feel safe, heard and respected while at school — a space in which honest instruction, growth and exploration should be expected and encouraged. For far too many Black students, however, this reality simply doesn't exist.

In an effort to spur much-needed change, the National Center for Youth Law recently joined with educators and others in addressing the United Nations Permanent Forum on People of African Descent. During the forum, held at U.N. Headquarters in New York City, Natasha Wilkins, Education Engagement Manager with the National Center for Youth Law, called on the U.N. Forum to **encourage all nations to commit to providing public education free from bans on materials and lessons that erase history and scholarship of and about people of African descent.**
