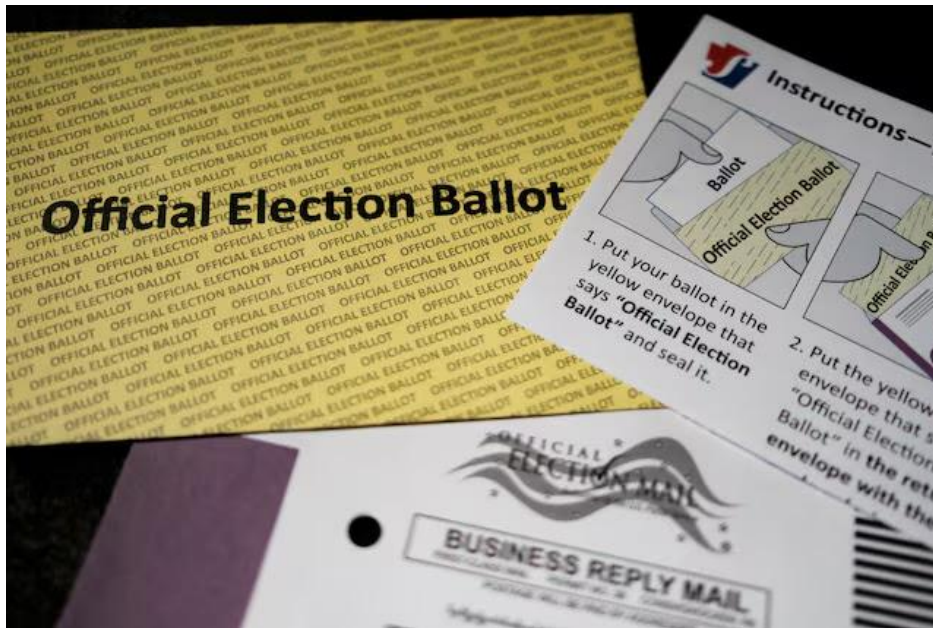

Reuters: [NAACP says US Postal Service mail-in voting plan violates settlement](#)

In its motion before the District Court for the District of Columbia, civil rights group the NAACP said the USPS rule would create a process “that directly violates its obligations” under a 2021 legal settlement which forced USPS officials to prioritize ballot mail and take “extraordinary measures” to ensure its timely delivery.

As a community, and as a society, we are too big to fit in that small box. We should be focused on building a global economy ... instead of 'othering.'"


